2009 Lacrosse Tournament Rules

This is a tournament that concludes with a champion. Each team is guaranteed three games. An award will be given to the Champion at each level.

Length of Games: Each game will consist of two - twenty minute halves. The officials will keep the game time, the penalty times and the score and will report the score to the command tent.

Point system to select Champion Teams:

- 1 point for winning the first half.
- If you are up by 5 goals at the half and win the game you get all the points.
- 2 points for winning the game.
- Point split in event of a tie at the end of either half.
- If a team plays four games, the first three games will be used for their point total.

Format:

- 3-3-3 + Goalie, regulation size field.
- Two 20 minute running halves with a five minute halftime; One 30 second time out per half.
- All technical penalties will be thirty seconds in length. Personal penalties will be one minute in length.
- No ten second clock, no body checks. Incidental body contact when playing the ball is allowed.
- During the last two minutes of the game, the team with the lead must advance the ball into the offensive half of the field without delay, as determined by the official (no stalling in the defensive half).
- New York State High School rules apply except as specified.

Roster: An adult coach must be responsible for the behavior of the team. A completed roster and a liability waiver form for each player is due at check in. Players may only be registered and play on one team.

Tiebreakers:



Braveheart will determine the winner of any game ending in a tie. The winner of braveheart will be awarded the two points for the game. If after the completion of all preliminary games, two teams are still tied for a playoff slot, the team to advance will be determined by the following: #1 head to head competition, #2 goals allowed, #3 goals scored.

Braveheart – One goalie from each team who cannot cross midfield and one other player from each team for the face off. This is sudden victory. Braveheart will also be used to determine the winner of Championship game if tied at the end of regulation time.
